- 19 Friday Comes in light breeze Southward Latter part the same.
- 20 Saturday Comes in light breeze to the Southward continued all day all sail out steering North
- 21 Sunday Comes in light breeze from the South all sail out steering North
- 22 Monday Comes in fresh breeze S. S. W. vessel steering to the North with main sail set on at 3 p.m. raised Whales lower L. B. struck on and then S. B. struck and got stove N. B. took whale boats came along side and made fast for the night

- 23 Tuesday Comes in fresh breeze from S. S. W. at 5 a.m. hooked on to the whale and at 8 a.m. finished cutting set the works ageing repaired S. B. at 6 p.m. took anchor to the North

- 25 Thursday Comes in light Eastly stove down the oil latter part the same 31-29 74-41

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- Apr. 27 Saturday Comes in light Southly wind in the Gulf Stream steering to the North took in sail at sunset
- " 28 Sunday Comes in with a fresh breeze from the N. N. E. Laker part moderating

- 29 Monday Comes in with a fresh breeze from the South saw 1 vessel Laker part the same got 2 porpoises

- 30 Tuesday Comes in light from the North also thick with fog Laker part the same
- May 1 Wednesday 73-23 Comes in with a fresh breeze from N. N. E. at noon went to the edge of the Stream no vessel in sight vessel under top sail and foresail.

- " 4 Saturday Comes in with a fresh breeze from the N. E. vessel heading to the North toiling Laker part the same

- " 5 Sunday Comes in with a good breeze from the N. E. set mainsail finished boiling set foresail and worked to the N. E. took in sail at sunset stove some oil down
- 6 Monday Comes in fresh breeze from the South East shortened sail at 10 a.m. Laker part more moderate and clear.
