

Remarks on Board Bark Berta of New Bedford Mass. 1878

Saturday Jan 19<sup>th</sup>

This Day Commences with a strong breeze from N to steering S by E by E at 7 A M left off Steady S by E saw two Sail watch Employed in getting Boat out the Fore Sail

Latitude 33-12 N Longitude 41 W

Sunday Jan 20<sup>th</sup>

This Day Commences with light variable Winds steering S by E at 1 P M a Calm with good Weather

Latitude by Observation 33-59 N

Monday Jan 21<sup>st</sup>

This Day Commences with a fine breeze from S steering by the Wind heading S by E sent the Cutting Benants at 1 P M and lashed them at 4 P M a Steady breeze single reefed the Top Sail saw nothing of Note

Tuesday Jan 22<sup>nd</sup>

This Day Commences with a Moderate Gale from S steering by the Wind heading S by E under close reefed Main Top Sail & Fore Sail saw nothing of Note

Latitude 34-35 N Longitude 58-30 W

Wednesday Jan 23<sup>rd</sup>

This Day Commences with a strong breeze from S by W steering S by E by E under Close reefed Top Sail and Fore Sail saw two Sails heading to the Westward clear Weather and a heavy Sea running

Latitude 34-42 N

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Thursday Jan 24<sup>th</sup>

This Day Commences with a fine breeze with a heavy swell the wind from S by W to N by Steady S at 4 P M a light breeze with rain some of Sail

Friday Jan 25<sup>th</sup>

This Day Commences with a fresh breeze from N to the N by Steady S by E with rain some of Sail heading to the Westward the Watch Employed in Ship's duty

Saturday Jan 26<sup>th</sup>

This Day Commences with a light variable Wind with rain at 1 P M a fine breeze from S steering by the Wind heading S by E the Watch to work on Rigging pulled the Mast Heads Four Main Latitude 34-20 N Longitude

Sunday Jan 27<sup>th</sup>

This Day Commences with a light breeze from S to W steering S by E with good Weather some of Fore-Breech White

Latitude 34-01 N Longitude 50-18 W

Monday Jan 28<sup>th</sup>

This Day Commences with a Calm at 5 P M a light air from S by E heading S by E Employed in overhauling the Cutting Board and getting it ready for use

Latitude 30-33 N Longitude 49-41 W

Tuesday Jan 29<sup>th</sup>

This Day Commences with a fresh breeze from S by W heading S by E saw some Black-Fish and the Sperm Finny Hairs passed under our Stern heading to the Westward the Watch Employed in Ship's Duty

Latitude 30-34 N Longitude 48-18 W
