

Ship Young Phoenix of New Bedford

Remarks on Board Sunday Dec^r 11th 1835

This day with a fine breeze from N^W & fine weather at 8 AM trip our anchors & steamed down the river at 10 AM discharge the pilot of the crew & pigs so gose this 12 hours

Remarks on Board Monday Dec^r 12th 1835

This day commences with a fine wind & pleasant weather from N^W steering S^{SE} with all sail out employed stowing the anchors & clearing the decks at 10 AM the main land bearing N by E by compass distance 50 miles from which I take my departure Middle & latter parts fine weather so ends

Lat 35.47 Long by Log 65.04 W

Remarks on Board Tuesday Dec^r 13th 1835

This 24 hours commences with a strong wind from N^W steering East by S with all towing sail set employed fitting the boats Middle part the same Latter part light air & pleasant weather so gose this 24 hours

Lat 33.45 Long by Log 65.40 W

Remarks on Board Wednesday Dec^r 14th 1835

This day commences with a light breeze from W^W at 4 AM luffed in to south and increased steering E by S with all sail set Middle part braced on close reefed fore & main topsails Latter part continued on at 9 AM took in the fore sail & came to under close reefed main topsail & reefed main trysail & fore topmast staysail at 10 AM took in main topsail & turn of the quarter boats so ends

Lat by D 32.45 Long 63.30

Remarks on Board Thursday Dec^r 15th 1835

First part a heavy gale from S^W having to under reef main staysail & fore topmast staysail Middle part same Latter part masted aft of steered E by S with all close reefed topsails & fore sail so gose this 24 hours

Lat by D 30.40 Long by Log 59.24
