These 24 hours begins with strong
breezes from the SW steering S by E
at sunset took in sail at daylight made
sail so ends Lat 30.36 S Long 104.32 E

Tuesday January ^{the} 21 1851
These 24 hours begins with strong
breezes from the S steering S W
all sail set middle and latter part the
same so ends Lat 30.12 S Long 104.10 E

Wednesday January ^{the} 22 1851
These 24 hours begins with strong
breezes from the S steering S
all sail set middle and latter part the same
so ends Lat 30.12 S Long 104.10 E

Thursday January ^{the} 23 1851
These 24 hours begins with light breezes
from the S steering E all sail set middle
and latter part the same so ends
Lat 33.20 S Long 104.10 E

Friday January ^{the} 24 1851
These 24 hours begins with light breezes from
the S steering E S E all sail set
middle and latter part the same so ends
Lat 33.12 Long 104.10 E

Saturday January ^{the} 25 1851
These 24 hours begins with light breezes
from the S steering S W all sail
set middle and latter part the same
so ends Lat 33.20 S Long 104.10 E

Sunday January ^{the} 26 1851
These 24 hours begins with light
breezes from the S W steering
S by S all sail set at 4 AM set the
fore topmast studding sail so ends
Lat 34.36 S Long 104.10 E

Monday January ^{the} 27 1851
These 24 hours begins with strong breeze from
the S W steering S E all sail set at 4
AM took in the fore topmast sail and
fly jib and fore topmast studding sail at
4.6 & set the main top gulant sail
so ends Lat 36.04 S Long 104.10 E

Tuesday January ^{the} 28 1851
These 24 hours begins with strong breezes
from the W steering E S E all sail set
middle and latter part the same so ends
Lat 36.58 S Long 104.10 E

Wednesday January ^{the} 29 1851
These 24 hours begins with light breezes
from the W steering S by S all sail
set 4.10 ends Lat 34.02 S Long 104.10 E
