Mon Day  
Feb 22

through the strong breezes from  
SW Course N.W. by N  
Lat 33° 48' N Long 69° 00' west

Tues Day  
Feb 23

first part strong breezes from  
SW Course N.W. by N at 9 AM  
wind hauled to the N.W. and N.E.  
latter part strong gales from  
N.W. ship under short sail  
Lat 35° 06' Long 70° 21' west

Wed Day  
Feb 24

first part strong gales from  
N.W. ship heading to the N.E.  
at 6 AM sent down the main  
mast and Clause reefed the  
top sails. latter part the  
strong breeze the trywankus  
amen board  
Lat 35° 13' N Long 70° 57' west

Thurs Day  
Feb 25

first part Calm and a heavy  
sea on at 9 AM a bright air  
from E Course N.W. by N  
latter part the same  
Lat 36° 25' Long 71° 3' west

Fri Day  
Feb 26

through the day moderate breezes  
from N.W. ship heading to the  
west Lat 38° 27' N Long 75° 56' by  
Chron long by baran 72° 16' west

Sat Day  
Feb 27

first part of these 24 hours strong  
breezes from E to E.S.E. ship heading  
N.W. latter part fresh gales  
from S.E. to E.S.E. at 8 AM found  
red and got 30 fathoms water  
the sounder gave ~~yellow~~ yellow  
sand with 66 shells in it and shells  
8° 0' obs to Day

Sun Day  
Feb 28

the day began with strong gales  
from S.E. ship heading West  
at 3 AM changed the lubber  
and took in fore and mizen topsails  
at 6 AM sounder 30 fathoms water  
latter part wind hauled to  
W.S.W. ship steering East by  
N at 4 AM hauled up & out  
at 9 AM made Long Island  
East Hampton at 11 AM made  
black 9 AM by N.E. by E Dist  
20 miles ship heading N.E. by E
