light Breezes from the S &  
steering by to the E N E.  
at 7 P.M. of our Boat going in  
going below slipped 3 steps from  
the Bottom and fell upon her  
Back what injury she received  
is not ascertained but I trust  
not anything serious it proved  
a severe shock that occasioned  
lameness nothing more which was  
fortunate. Latter part Employed  
Boiling the 83 fish it made 14 Bbs
