In November 71. Caulked sparred, sheathed
and covered with metal below the wales.

Top caulked above wales, and thick sheathing
covering wales caulked. Baking good order.

Bark Seizee John P Knowles Oct 1844.

Oct 1841 new main transoms, on new counter
timber; new counter planks; upper part
stem part new; top caulked.

April 1842. new keelson, new fir-ties, and
new wooden joints. 14 new streaks, bottom
plank from keel up, between wood ends (which
had been previously new) all fastened through
with turnbuckles, and wedged. Floor timbers
re-fastened to keel fore and aft. Bottom caulked
counter, sheathed and capped. Vessel
in good order.
