

Chronological Memoranda continued

- 1821 Went to New York October 27th in Sloop Huntsress Whipple Brown Master, remained there until December 3, and sailed as passenger on board Brig Jane, Pezel Fowler, Master, for St. Barts, and arrived 23rd 9 A.M. Same day at 1 P.M. took passage on board Sch. Eliza Rye, Robert Waterman Master, and arrived in St. Thomas next day. Remained in St. Thomas 8 days and from thence to St. Croix where I remained until the 9th August 1822, when I sailed for Middletown Connecticut, in Brig Betsy Dole, Capt. Robinson, and arrived off Saybrook bar September 2. Went on shore the 3rd at Saybrook. Hired a sail boat & left the Brig at 9 A.M. of the 4th and arrived at Newport at midnight, and Providence on the 6th. Sailed November 20 for Havana, in Brig Mary Ann
- 1823 William Tew Master, and returned February 15, 1823. Sailed April 8th in Brig Janus, John Haradon Jr. Master to Baltimore, and returned May 1st. Sailed 15th May same vessel, same Master to Hamburg, and returned September 1st. Sailed November 10 to Havana in Brig Mary Ann William Tew Master and returned January 11, 1824. Sailed Brig Janus John Haradon Jr. Master to St. Eustatia, St. Barts and St. Croix June 6th and returned August 23. Sailed October 12 in the same vessel, same Captain to the coast of Africa anchoring for trade at Goree Island, Gallinas River
- 1825 Sullima, Manna Rock, Sugar River, Cape Mount Liberia (Cape Monserado), Cape Palmas, Olimina Castle, thence to Princeps Island and arriving at Providence June 29th 1825. Sailed November 16 in Brig Mary Ann (myself Master) to Havana and arrived in 15 days. Sailed from Havana Jan 9th
- 1826 1825 and arrived at Newport Jan 26th and Providence January 30th.

- 1826 Sailed from Providence July 3 and Dutch Island 5th in Brig Enterprise John Haradon Jun. Master to Matanzas arriving July 23. Sailed from Matanzas in Schooner Hyder M. Capt. Daniels Laid. August 14 and arrived at Philadelphia September 1. Remained in Philadelphia, (visiting Philadelphia, Bucks and Montgomery Counties and over on the Jersey side) until
- 1827 May 31, 1827 when I took passage in Schooner Herald Anna Hall, Master, and arrived in Providence June 7th. Sailed December 24th in Brig Mary Ann William Martin, Master, to Mobile and arrived back in Feb 1828.
- 1828 Remained in Providence until October 2 when I took passage in Sloop Herald Whipple Brown Master to Fall River, Newport, off New London and to New York where, after remaining a week, from thence by Steam and land carriage to Philadelphia. Remained there until November 26th and took passage in Sch. Herald David Hall Master and returned Dec 3 to Providence.
- 1829 Remained at home until March 31st 1829 when I sailed in Brig George Washington John Haradon Jr. Master to the City of Saint Domingo (Hayti) and returned June 30th 1829. Sailed October 27th in Brig Mary Ann William Norris Master to Havana. Resided in Havana from 13th to 24th December and at Mrs Perry's at the Regla from that time (with the exception of 9 days in the City) until February 22 1830, at which time I commenced the Journal on the next page.
