

- 1) TWO COMPLETE WHALING VOYAGES of the Ship Herald of Fairhaven, Mass., Zenas Dillingham, Master, on a Sperm and Right Whale Voyage to the South Atlantic. Kept by Philander Daggett daily from July 30th 1835 through April 12th 1836 and on the second voyage from August 12th 1836 through April 11th 1838. A neatly kept and most decorative manuscript with numbered whale stamps (colored with a red spout) also pen and pencil (all in Daggett's hand) drawings of many ships spoken, blackfish & porpoises taken (and even a sunfish!) There are two rough pencil drawings of the Herald. Folio, original $\frac{1}{2}$ calf and marbled board (several ink stains) binding; 145 pages plus 9 more of ships spoken and poetry & prose penned at sea. [PLEASE ILLUSTRATE]
