

230 Tuesday 15th March
Begins with fresh winds and rough
sea, studding sail, mid and lower
parts, which the same saw a sail
steering N. Lat, 14°38' N Long 40°59' W

231 Wednesday 16th
Commences with fresh winds
from NE all sail set steering NE by
middle and lower parts (light)
winds and falcasans
Lat, 16°09' Long 43°17'

232 Thursday 17th
Commences with light winds from NE
and falcasans mid parts, wind and
weather about the same at 10 wind hauls
to East, Lat, 17°22' Long 44°56'

233 Friday 18th
Begins with light winds from E and
fine weather mid parts, variable and
calm at 7 light breezes from N latter
parts, heavy squalls from the N took
in top gallant sails and reefed topsails
Lat, 17°54' Long 45°26'

234 Saturday 19th
First parts, strong winds from NE
and rain at 2 PM, made let out, reefs
and set top gallant sails wind variable
veered to NE Lat, 18°01' Long 45°56'

235 Sunday 20th
Commences with strong breezes
from NW heading NE by NW fresh
squalls took in top gallant sails and
double reefed the topsails mid
parts, made made sail latter parts,
calm Lat, 18°37' Long 46°44'

236 Monday 21st
First parts, calm at 10 light breezes
from S course NE by NE mid parts, mid
latter parts, fresh winds and
falcasans took a lunar obs Long
47°38' 45' W by Chron 47°11' 15" W
Lat, 19°47'

237 Tuesday 22nd
Commences with light winds from
PE and falcasans mid fresh squally
took in top gallant sails A.M. made sail
ends with fresh winds and falcasans
Lat, 20°55' Long 49°31'

238 Wednesday 23rd
Begins with strong winds from NE
and fresh squally latter parts
fine weather Lat, 22°24' Long 52°13'

239 Thursday 24th
Commences with fresh winds
and fine weather all sail set, steering
NW by W mid parts, wind light
latter parts squally Lat, 23°37' Long 54°18'

240 Friday 25th
Begins with strong winds course
NW by N mid parts thick latter
parts, fresh winds and squalls
Lat, 24°30' Long 57°29'

241 Saturday 26th
First parts, fresh winds from
PE and fine weather middle
parts, made at 10, unbent the main
top sail to repair Lat, 25°21' Long 59°32'

242 Sunday 27th
Strong winds from NE and falcasans
and at 10 bent the main top sail
and set a sail steering NE mid and
latter parts, fresh winds and
squally Lat, 26°58' Long 62°13'

243 Monday 28th
Begins with fresh winds from S
and thick weather at 10 took in main
sails and reefed the topsails at 4
heavy squalls carried away the ma
in top gallant wind shifted to NW
took in sail and hove to
at 7 made and variable with rain
at 10 set the fore and main top
sails ends with strong gales
