Tuesday 22 3 days
 born with light winds & foggy under all
 sail by the wind E.S.E. had at 2 middle part
 March 22 sun latter part with sun weather
 foggy at 10 middle part in setting the sun
 ends at 4 P.M. by I R 40-20 W 40-40 W

Wednesday 23
 born with light winds & thick fog steering
 by the wind E.S.E. under all sail at 8
 at 4 P.M. the capt. hurt himself had
 had much to do with boat for taken at
 6 P.M. tacked ship and steered W.N.W. middle
 part latter part into foggy and rainy 24 ends
 No Ob. Let by I R 40-10 W 40-15

Thursday 24
 commenced foggy and rainy weather
 24 of steering W.N.W. at 6 P.M. spoke the East
 point with 12 or middle part steered to S.E.
 at 11 sun Black Island bearing N.W. 1/2
 1/2 leagues of sailing in beating the ship
 commenced at 12 the 24 ends at 1 P.M.
