Monday 3 August 1846

Blowing strong gale from the S.W. Stearing to the South spoke the ship Neptune of L.L. two whales saw the ship Inogul but did not speak her gamed with the Neptune to dark sailed both alike

Tuesday 4 August

Foggy weather and blowing fresh gale from S.W. to S.W. Stearing by the wind under double reefed top sails to the South

Latt Long

Wednesday 5 Aug

Clear pleasant weather gaming with the Neptune and Inogul latter part spoke the ship Acushnet 2 whales latter part all four ships in company Stearing S.W. wind from S.W. saw two fin backs

Thursday 6 Aug

Pleasant weather with light winds from the S.W. Stearing S.W. sent up the fore and Mizzen top gale masts flying jib boom and fore and main royals masts

Latt Long

Friday 7 Aug

Pleasant weather with light winds from West Stearing South three sails in sight all standing to the South under all sail

Latt Long

Saturday 8 Aug

Pleasant weather with light breezes from the West Stearing South under all sail four sails in sight

Latt Long

Sunday 9 Aug

Light breeze from S.W. to South and squally Stearing by the wind to the South and Eastward saw several fin backs five sails in sight all bound South

Monday 10 Aug 1846

Pleasant weather with light southerly breeze Stearing by the wind to the East caught two porpoises five sail in sight

Tuesday 11 Aug

Light air from the South Stearing by the wind S.S.E. four sails in sight

Latt Long

Wednesday 12 Aug

Light air from the South and S.S.E. Stearing by the Wind to the West three sails in sight employed washing ship latter part commenced painting

Thursday 13 Aug

Calms for the most part of this day finished painting ship out side large quantities of Porpoises all round

Latt Long

Friday 14 Aug

Calms throughout this day had considerable disturbance with the steward he threatened the Captan be flogged him and put him in irons and chased him down in a state room he is an ugly devil commenced repairing the rigging nothing in sight whatever

Saturday 15 Aug

Calms throughout this day nothing in sight what whatever employed in the rigging

Sunday 16 Aug

Light air from the S.E. standing to the S.W. caught one porpois nothing else in sight
