Monday 17 Aug 1846

Calm throughout this day large quantities of Carpses all round employed in the rigging Latt Long

Tuesday 18 Aug

Heavy rain for the most part of this day nothing in sight whatever calm throughout Latt Long

Wednesday 19 Aug

Calm throughout this day nothing in sight whatever employed in the rigging Latt Long

Thursday 20 Aug

Light breeze from the Eastward steering to the south Latt Long

Friday 21 Aug

Strong breeze from N E to day steering south caught a porpoise Latt Long

Saturday 22 Aug

Strong gale from East steering south employed painting the inside of the ship nothing in sight Latt Long

Sunday 23 Aug

Strong trade to day and steering to the south one barque in sight standing to the south overhauling her fast Latt Long

Monday 24 Aug

Blowing fresh with the strong squalls bearing south one sail in sight Latt Long

Tuesday 25 Aug

Blowing fresh from the E to N E steering south two sails in sight Latt Long

Wednesday 26 Aug 1845

Blowing fresh from E N E shortened sail through the night at 8 o'clock raised the N E point of lower ran for the entrance distant about 15 miles 8 sails in sight Latt Long

Thursday 27 Aug

Came to anchor in Lohina Harbour Island of Bouee at 5 o'clock and commenced gowing through the same rotene of work as always goes on in port got a raft of casks on shore for water and black the hands one watch ashore on liberty

Friday 28 Aug

Lying at anchor got off a raft of water and stowed it down had a few words with the Captain and Mate about gowing on shore for a few minutes and leaving the ship without any officer on board of her the Mate having the fourth Mate leave to go on shore with the Carboons watch on liberty and leaving me on board of the ship to carry on the work on board and ashore at the same time and still to be on the watch

Saturday 29 Aug

Look a raft of casks on shore got of thirty barrel of Meat
