

Remarks on board of Ship Niger

Passage from St Helena
This 24 hours with a fresh breeze
from S.W. at two P.M. we
got our soundings at 2.4
Fathoms at 4 P.M. up with
Block Island & point could
be seen whistling ~~was~~ close to
the Island as it was a thick
fog and we could not see
the Land bore $\text{E} \text{ N} \text{ E}$ at 5 P.M.
It cleared up a little but not so
as to see the Land at 8 P.M. began
to see the light at 11 Middle Point
it shut down thick at 11-15 struck
on the shoals south of Sumphing
Light with some $\text{N} \text{ E}$ distance
of a $\frac{1}{4}$ of a Mile Run out and
anchor and at 5-30 A.M. we got
her off and come up the River
and at 7 A.M. we lost anchor
above Palmers Island The
Ship Nigers Voice
