the north and a heavy sea on middle part
the same latter part strong winds and
Rough weather saw two sails to sea

Thursday 23 these 24 hours commences with strong winds
from the north middle part the same latter
part strong winds and rough weather saw
one ship and one brig to the Eastward
Lat 37.56 N Long 71.34 W

Friday 24 these 24 hours commences with strong winds
from the north and rough weather middle part
the same latter part the winds from the
the Eastward and pleasant weather in site
Lat 35.25 N Long 71.23 W

Saturday 25 these 24 hours commences with gentle
breezes from the south and Eastward
and pleasant weather middle part gentle
breezes from the westward and pleasant
latter part the same weather in site
Lat 33.40 N Long 71.15 W

Sunday 26 these 24 hours commences with light winds
from the westward one sail in site
middle part strong winds from the
westward and pleasant weather latter part
the same weather in site to day
Lat 31.34 N Long 70.17 W
