

CROMWELL AND CLEVELAND PAPERS

Containing letters to and from Whaling Master Peter Cromwell and his wife, Susan, of Holmes Hole, Martha's Vineyard, and letters from Jacob and William Cleveland home all covering the period 1845 - 1858.

Some letters are un-dated and have been arranged as nearly chronologically as possible.
