 cranes heavy Sea Running 2 Schs in sight
 Middle and latter part the same Sch in
 sight and a Steamer saw Whales at 5 P.M.
 heading to the Windward here and quit now
 So Ends Lat 38.10 Long 71.30

Saturday June 23
 Comes with light ars from South and
 Thunder and lightning and Rain Sch
 heading N.W. Under Short Sail middle
 and latter part the same Swept in sight
 So Ends Lat 38.15 Long 70.10

Sunday June 24
 Comes with light S.W. Winds and clear
 Sch heading to N.W. all sail out middle
 and latter part Squally Sch heading N.W.
 the Swept in sight So Ends
 Lat 38.21 Long 71.30

Monday June 25
 Comes with light North Winds and clear
 Sch heading N.W. all sail out middle
 part Short Sail latter part light
 Winds headed S.W. all sail out 2 Sch in
 sight So Ends
 Lat 37.57 Long 72.40

Tuesday June 26
 Comes with light ars and calm middle part
 the same latter part light Winds from S.E.
 and South Sch headed on deprent Tacks
 Spoke the Ellen Swept So Ends
 Lat 37.35 Long 72.25
