Journal of A Whaling voyage in Leeward of the
 1841 at 8 a.m. from basket and stand down river
 at 12 landed the Pilot at basket half point
 so ends these 24 hours

Friday there 24 hours commences with breeze from the
 1841 South and westward mid pleasant water
 saw a ship standing to the south at 6 P.M. black
 Island bearing by way of S.W. by S. but 20 miles saw a
 big middle part strong winds from the South and
 at 3 P.M. westward latter part the same saw a ship to the East
 by 11.30 P.M. so ends these 24 hours

Saturday there 24 hours commences with strong winds from the South
 1841 and Eastward and rough water middle part strong
 winds from the South and Eastward and rough latter
 part the same nothing in site thick foggy
 so ends these 24 hours

Sunday there 24 hours commences with a strong gale from
 1841 the South and Eastward mid a very heavy swell on
 and very squally middle part blowing but quiet the
 main part latter part the wind bent to the South
 at 3 P.M. and westward and very rough some squally
 so ends these 24 hours

Monday there 24 hours commences with strong winds
 1841 March 28 from the South and westward and rough water
 and very squally middle part strong winds
 and very squally winds from the South and
 westward latter part the wind from the West
 and squally and rough a very heavy sea on
 so ends these 24 hours
