1841 and a very heavy sea on sea a-buig laying two  
middle part a very strong gale from the  
south and westward and a very heavy sea on  
the latter part the same and squally weather  
by 34.30  
by 64.18 So ends these 24 hours.

Wednesday these 24 hours commences with strong winds  
march the 11 from the south and westward and a very heavy  
1841 sea on setting in site of us squally and rainy  
middle part the wind slacked and the sea went  
down some latter part strong winds and some  
#32.54 raged but not so squally as it has been  
by 60.16 So ends these 24 hours

Thursday these 24 hours commences with strong winds from  
march the 11 south and westward and raged with imployade  
1841 in setting up the buckettes and bobstais making  
in site middle part like winds from the westward  
and pleasant weather latter part strong and  
#31.46 S the south and westward and raged with  
by 59.53 So ends these 24 hours

Friday these 24 hours commences with strong winds from  
march the 12 south and westward and raged and squally weather  
1841 middle part strong wind from the south and  
westward and raged latter part like winds and  
#30.19 a rainy with sea one sail to the south of us  
by 59.00 all lands imployade in fitting boats  
So ends these 24 hours

Saturday these 24 hours commences with like wind from the south  
march the 13 and smoky with imployade in fitting boats mid part  
1841 like winds from the south and pleasant weather  
latter part like winds from the south and  
#29.30 S eastward and sail to the south imployade in fitting  
by 54.10 boats So ends these 24 hours

Sunday these 24 hours commences with like winds from the south  
march the 14 and pleasant weather imployade in fitting boats and  
1841 getting ready for whaling middle part strong from  
south and eastward and pleasant weather latter  
part strong winds from the south and west  
#28.75 and pleasant weather setting in site  
by 55.14 So ends these 24 hours

Monday these 24 hours commences with strong winds  
march the 15 from the south and eastward and raged weather  
1841 but pleasant the back lost his down bucket and  
middle part like winds from the south and eastward  
and pleasant weather latter part fine weather all lands  
#28.08 S imployade in fitting boats and getting ready for  
by 55.14 whaling So ends these 24 hours

Tuesday these 24 hours commences with gentle breezes from the  
march the 16 south and eastward and pleasant weather all lands  
1841 imployade in fitting boats and craft and getting  
ready middle part like winds from the south and  
eastward latter part fine breezes from the south  
#25.49 and eastward and pleasant weather imployade in  
by 53.30 fitting gear So ends these 24 hours

Wednesday these 24 hours commences with gentle breezes from the  
march the 17 south and eastward and pleasant weather middle  
1841 part fine weather and strong breezes latter part  
#25.22 the same all lands in imployade in fitting whaling  
by 53.46 gear So ends these 24 hours

Thursday these 24 hours commences with strong breezes from  
march the 17 south and eastward and pleasant weather sail a  
1841 barge standing to the south and westward  
middle part gentle breezes from the south and  
eastward and pleasant weather imployade in  
#21.18 S fitting gear for whaling  
by 54.43 So ends these 24 hours
