these 24 hours Commences with
Lite winds from the S.W. and
all hands employed in making
sail at 2 p.m. we came out side
at 6 p.m. block and bare in
by Compass west dist 15 miles
middle part Lite winds and steam
weather latter part the same
a number of sails in site of us
So Ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 40.36 Long 71.42 W

Sunday
July the 1
1838

these 24 hours Commences with
Lite Breezes from the northward
a number of sails in site of us
middle part Lite winds and
foggy weather latter part
Lite winds from the south west
Saw 1 off all saw one sail
So Ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 38.28 Long 72.00 W
