Oct the 10
1839
Journal of a whale voyage on board of the brig *Arcturion*
Commences with lite winds from the south west and pleasant
at 9 am got under weigh in sea before the stream at 12
O'clock went thro' guise lead So Ends this day

Friday
Oct the 11
1839
these 24 hours commences with lite winds from the west
west and pleasant with at a fast gay lead at 5 P M
Woman's land bearing by compass N 40 E Dist 12 m
middle part strong winds and raged under Dubel night
Lat 39.57
long 70.10
by sail latter part strong wind and raged water
So Ends these 24 hours

Saturday
Oct the 12
1839
these 24 hours commences with strong winds from
North East and raged water middle part strong
winds from the North and Eastward latter part strong
Lat 38.18
long 68.26
Wind and squally water sitting in site of us
So Ends these 24 hours

Sunday
Oct the 13
1839
First part of these 24 commences with strong winds
from the East and very raged water some
squalls of rain all hands sea sick and some sick
Lat 37.30
long 66.49
middle part lite winds and raged water latter
the same winds from the S S E and cloudy
So Ends these 24 hours

Monday
Oct the 14
1839
these 24 hours commences with lite winds from
the South and Eastward one sail in site stand
ing to the westward a brig thick cloudy water
middle part strong winds and squally latter part
the same rainy water and raged water
So Ends these 24 hours

Tuesday
Oct the 15
1839
these 24 hours commences with strong winds from
the South and Eastward and rising water and raged
middle part some heavy squalls from the S S W
and a heavy swell on latter part strong winds
Lat 38.12
long 64.30
and raged water saw a ship to the westward
So Ends these 24 hours
