1839 middle part strong winds from the south and west
lat 35.47 latter part strong winds and pleasant weather nothing
long 58.40 in site so ends these 24 hours

Sunday these 24 hours commences with strong winds from the
Oct the 21 south and westward saw nothing middle part gentle
1839 breeze from the north latter part strong winds
lat 35.20 from the E.N.E. and squally some rain and rough
long 57.00 saw one sail to the westward of us
