Monday Nov 29 1846
The Captain and board got under
weigh at 4 o'clock anchor off Newport
Hauled the sails and set the water
for the night to make the day

Tuesday Nov 30
Strong winds from the N.W. still
fairly off Newport with a gale of
wind from the north west at 3 P.M.
more moderate later part wind
nor W by W very cold which makes
me think on home so ends the day

Wednesday December 1
At 6 P.M. took our anchor in Newport
harbour took part to sea middle part
employed stowing our anchor leaving
up the deck strong winds from
the N.W. stowing H & B as fast
the wind will carry us so ends

Thursday Dec 2
Commenced in with light air from the
north at 4 P.M. wind held to the
west braced the yards same at 6
held to the north squaring middle
part at 6 P.M. took in main top
gabant sail and double reefed the
topsails at 4 o'clock reefed later part
strong gales from the S.E. so ends
