Remarks On Board Thursday January 24th 1859

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with light air
from the SSB and foggy with show of rain Ship heading
in a wind to the East, Middle Part light Wind and variable
with show of rain, at 9 AM tack in main top Gallant
Sail, Latter Part Fresh Gale from the West with squalls
of hail Steering the Ship, I land So ends these 24 hours,

Lat in 4th Ob - 45. 38 S
Long in 4th Ob - 31. 15 E

Remarks On Board Friday January 24th 1859

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with gentle Gale
from the West & squally Ship heading to the S, Middle Part
Fresh Gale and squally at 10 AM Double reef the Top Gale
& tack in the S, Latter Part Fresh Gale & squally Ship
heading to the S, Middle Part from the N, W, with a heavy sea running
So ends these 24 hours,

Lat in 4th Ob - 46. 00 S
Long in 4th Ob - 35. 49 E

Remarks On Board Saturday January 26th 1859

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with Fresh Breeze from
the N, W, with heavy Squalls of Wind & hail Steering the Ship S, B
under Double reef Top Gale, Middle Part light Wind & Pleasant
Weather at 4 AM Saw Prince Edward's Island, leaving S, B,
Distance 30 miles ran several fine Boats Latter Part gentle Breeze
from the West Steering the Ship S by South under all Sails
So ends these 24 hours

Indian Ocean Cruising for Right Whales
Remarks On Board Sunday January 27th 1859

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with Fresh Breeze
from the N, W, with show of rain Steered by South at 4 PM
Came thick and rainy took in Sail & let the Ship by to under short
Sail heading to the N, B, Middle Part foggy with show of rain
at 6 AM fog cleared up made sail on the Ship at 9 AM ran
Several Squalls, Latter Part Fresh Breeze from the West
inter mixed fog Steering the Ship N, B by E So ends
these 24 hours,

Remarks On Board Monday January 28th 1859

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with Fresh Breeze
from the N, W, with fog Steering the Ship N, B by S ran
several fine Boats at 5 PM tack in Sail & let the Ship
by to under short Sail heading to the N, B, Middle Part
gentle Breeze from the N, W, with thick & foggy at 9 AM made
Sail on the Ship ran several fine Boats Latter Part light
Winds intermixed with fog Ship heading to the N, B So ends
these 24 hours,

Lat in 4th Ob 44. 20 S

Remarks On Board Tuesday January 29th 1859

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with light wind
and variable intermixed with fog Ship heading to the East
at 7 AM tack in Sail & let the Ship by to under short
Sail Middle & Latter Part Fresh Breeze from the North with
thick foggy weather Ship lying too under short Sail heading
to S, N, B So ends these 24 hours,
