the N.W. and heavy squalls
headed North under
close reefed top sails and courses
at dark in squalls and spencers
fore and Mizzen
to the N.W. wind
Middle part calm

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For Whales in South Atlantic
Wednesday Sept 3
Begins with a moderate breeze
from the North steered West
at 4 P.M. strong gale heard ship
head to the S.W.
Middle part a gale
Latter the same saw one ship
Lat 37° 00'

Thursday Sept 4th
All there 24 hours a gale of
wind from N.W. Lay too
saw one ship
Lat 37° 20'

Friday Sept 5th
Begins with a gale from N.W.
and heavy sea lay too head to
the N.W. saw for Back's
Middle part a gale
Latter more moderate made sail
headed to the North two ships in
sight saw nothing of the whale kind
Lat by Obs 36° 41'
Long 11° 42' W

Saturday Sept 6th
Begins with a moderate breeze at
tacked ship to the S.W.
at sunset in squalls
in sail heard ship
within 25 miles at 8 P.M. saw
ship head to N.W. under
Middle part strong gales
and heavy squalls
Latter more moderate made sail
stood to the N.W. saw nothing
Lat 36° 25'
