nothing thus far speed 8 knots

begins fine P. may it end so  
with fresh trades and no rain  
Middle part fine weather  
and fresh trades

Latter the same speed 7 knots

weather course S. W. by S speed 7 knots  
with all drawing sail set  
Middle part fine
