July 21st } Commenced with light and variable winds
at 3 P.M. got underway in company with
ship Majestic with a light breeze from
N.W. at 4. wind hauled S.W. ship worked
out of the Bay. at 12 P.M. Discharged
the Pilot of Cuttenhunk. Middle and
Latter parts light airs and Calms
several sail in sight Fog Head and Norway
Land bearing N.E.

Friday
July 22nd } Commenced with light and variable winds
ship heading S. several sail in sight.
employed in stowing the anchors & cables
Betting Boats. Middle and Latter
parts light airs and Calms employed
in ships duties. Lat 40.38 N
Long 71.02 W

Saturday
July 23rd } Commenced with light and variable
winds ship heading N.E. by E several
sail in sight. Middle part wind
hauled. S.W. Tacked ship to the S. Latter
part Fog and Rain with variable
winds Lat 40.25
Long 70.25

Sunday
July 24th } Commenced with light variable winds
heading S.E. by E. at 4 P.M. wind hauled
S.W. heading E. spoke with Brig
Wilberforce of Quibek. Bound to New York
at 7 P.M. Took in the top gallant
sails double reefed the top sails Middle
part the same. Latter part fine breeze
from S.W. made all sail. saw a school
of Blk. Fish. Lat 40.20
Long 68.12
