Remarks On Board Saturday July 29th

A mending the foresail at 4 P M set a reef jib & then reef
mainsail fore sail in sight at 6 P M finished mending the
foresail took in the storm top sail & bent it & took on reef
it & set it the middle & latter parts a declining gale
the S E at sunset took in jib & mainsail & lay to
ing to the S W at daylight set the same & wore ship
N E at 10 A M turned the reef out the jib & fore
mainsail employed in set duty so ends Lat 27, 47 N

Remarks On Board Sunday July 30th
The first part of these twenty four hours fresh breeze from the
S E steering to the N E at 1 P M spoke the ship Malabar
of Marseilles at 2 made all sail & sail in sight the middle
& latter parts moderate breeze from the E at 4 P M single
reef at daylight made all sail & steered to the N E
sails in sight so ends Lat 28, 01 N

Remarks On Board Monday July 31st
These twenty four hours commenced with moderate breeze
from the E A standing to the N E at 1 P M tacked to the
S all sail set cloudy weather a few drops of rain at 2
P M caught 2 dolphins saw spoils one sail in sight at 4
calm the middle part calm at sunset shortened sail at 6
A M a light breeze from the E S E made all sail the last
part moderate breeze from the E S E A standing on both
tacks & sails in sight saw grampuses so ends Lat 28, 08 N

Remarks On Board Tuesday August 1st
These twenty four hours commenced with fresh breeze from
the E S E A standing on both tacks & sails in sight saw
breaches & spoils supposed them to be grampuses the middle
part fresh breeze from the E at sunset single reefed A
steered to the S at daylight tacked to the N N E at

Nehemiah West Master. Act. 1808

At 4 P M hoisted the reef out the foresail the last
part fresh breeze breeze from the E A standing to the
N N E at 10 A M took the reef out the mainsail
& set the jib top sail saw grampuses & sails in sight
at noon spoke the bark Neptune of Marseilles so
ends Lat 27, 37 N

Remarks On Board Wednesday August 2nd
The first part of these twenty four hours fresh breeze from
the E A standing to the N N E at 50 minutes
Landed bearing N E & sails in sight the middle
part fresh breeze from the E S E equally at sunset
single reefed took in fly jib & jib top sail the last
breeze from the E at 3 A M turned the reef out the
foresail & one out the mainsail & set fly jib &
tacked to the N E at 10 turned the reef out the
mainsail & set jib top sail saw grampuses & corfish
& porpois at noon spoke bark City N by compass pico & emp
A breaking out the reef & small stars & sails in
sight so ends Lat 28, 06 S

Remarks On Board Thursday August 3rd
The first part of these twenty four hours light breeze from
the E S E A standing to the N E & sails in sight at
one P M discovered the fly jib stay to be stowed came
up with it & repaired it & set it up the middle
part fresh breeze from the E S E A standing to the N E at
sunset single reefed & tacked to the S at 2 A M
S E tacked to the N E the last part a moderate
breeze from the S E A standing to the N E at 9 A M
turned the reef out saw grampuses shot one in
the small employed A mending the mainsail &
showing yards & spars in fore at noon bearing N E
so ends
