

Tuesday Aug 14 1872

Lat 37.17
Long 57.56
First part of this day good breeze from the SW ship steering $E\frac{1}{2}S$ Middle and Latter parts strong breeze and frequent squalls, saw one spout and three sails Employed in making the boat sails bent the fore stay sail and performed ships duty and so ends this day.

Wednesday Aug 15.

First part of this day blowing a strong breeze from the NW steering $E\frac{1}{2}S$ Middle part the same took in the light sails and reefed the main top sail Latter part moderate made sail. Employed working on the boat sails saw several sails broke out water and so ends.

Thursday Aug 16

First part of this day good breeze from the W steering $E\frac{1}{2}S$ Middle part the same Latter part strong breeze and rain squalls Employed in ship duty saw one fin back and two sails made two new line covers and so ends.

Friday Aug 17

Lat 38.43
Long 44.23
First part of the 24 hours good breeze ship heading SE Middle part the same Latter part strong breeze took sail Employed in ship duty saw one fin back and two sails and so ends.

Saturday Aug 18

Lat 38.12
Long 46.23
First part of this day strong breeze ship heading SE Middle part the same Latter part the wind let up to ESE saw one sail and so ends.

Sunday Aug 19 1872

Lat 39.20
First part of this day strong breeze steering SE Latter part the same Middle part moderate spoke bark on ward Capt. Hayes boiling 70 barrel whale and so ends this day at sun down took in sail.

Monday Aug 20

Lat 39.34
First part moderate breeze Middle part the same Latter part light air and calm saw four whale ships. Employed in ship duty lowered the boat for exercise at sun down took in sail.

Tuesday Aug 21

Lat 40.07
First part light breeze Middle part moderate Latter part strong breeze took in sail saw one fin back and three sails broke out water and flour got the cutting stage ready ship cruising and so ends.

Wednesday Aug 22

Lat 40.53
Per. 3 1/2
First part of this day strong breeze Middle part squally Latter part the same saw one sail Wind SE ship cruising Broke out cloth and Molasses and stores and three coils of towline at sun down took in sail and so ends this day.

Thursday Aug 23

Lat 40.46
First part of this day strong breeze at day light made sail and wore ship heading WSW Middle part moderate Latter part the same saw one sail and a school of grampus Employed in ship duty. Carpenter sick at sun down wore ship and so ends.
