to North steering E 1/2 S washed the
Ship inside

Wednesday Nov 8th Lat 39.52 Long 131.33
To day light hazy
wind steering East saw the Jessie
Freeman steering the same and dried the
Board & bundled it

Thursday Nov 9th Lat 39.24 Long 129.40
To day light breeze
from North steering E until 3 PM then
E 1/2 S with the Jessie Freeman in
sight

Friday Nov 10th Lat 39.11 No Obs
To day light hazy wind
with fog at intervals washed the
Ship outside saw no sail
