To day light Breeze from
N East steering N N West

Tuesday March 27th Lat 25.45 Long 165.12
This day light Breeze
from S East catching N N West
took in two Bow & Mast
Boats

Wednesday March 28th Lat 26.03 Long 165.34
To day fine weather &
light Breeze from S East steering
N N West until 3 PM then N by
West not any thing seen

Thursday March 29th Lat 26.16 Long 165.32
This day light Breeze from
S East at 5 PM wind calm
got up Steam & commenced to Steam
steering N by West.

TUESDAY, AUGUST 13, 1889

Friday March 30th Lat 29.35 Long 165.59
To day begins with light Breeze
from N East under Steam & fore & aft
Sails during N N West at 8 AM Breeze
w/ shifted Steaming & made sail look
in the cutting Stage

Saturday March 31st Lat 30.50 Long 166.57
To day light Breeze from East
to S East steering N by West the N N West
at 6 PM commenced Steaming

Sunday March April 1st Lat 31 Long
This day begins nearly Calm
at 4 AM got Breeze West Shift under
Steam at 8 AM made sail & started
Steaming steering N N West at 6 PM started
Steaming again

Monday April 2nd Lat 34.08 Long 167.25
This day begins with light
Breeze from North under Steam at 3 PM
got Breeze from S East made sail
& started steaming steering N N
West saw one vessel called it
the Alexander
