Sunday Nov 4th Lat 42 or Long 133.31
To day strong Breeze
from South heading E by S
under Topsails fogg mist of
the tint

Monday Nov 5th Lat 41 or Long 130.46
To day light Breeze
from South steering E by S
fogg mist the tint employed
in Bundling Bone between decks

Tuesday Nov 6th Lat 40.06 Long 129.215
To day light Breeze
from S West the breeze at day
E S East to E by S at 11
at 11 started Steaming employed
in Bundling Bone between
Decks at 12 O'Clock Breeze of
fresh from North started Steaming

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 26, 1889

Wednesday Nov 7th Lat 38.52 Long 125.45
To day fresh Breeze from
North steering from E by S at
6 P.M. wind died out started
Steaming

Thursday Nov 8th
To day murky calm
Ship under Sails steering E by S
at 10 A.M. sighted the land Point
Rogers at noon came in thick fogg
at 2 P.M. heard the whistle on Point
Rogers steering for the Whistling
Buoy round in every hour at 8
P.M. heard the Bony of a Pilot Boat
took aboard at Pilot he took
us in & anchored us inside the Bar

Friday Nov 9th begins with thick fogg
at 9th took the anchor & went in
the Gate & anchored again off the Providence
at 11th took the anchor again & went
in & anchored off the Oceanic Docks
the fogg cleared a little so ends
this voyage
