SUNDAY, OCTOBER 27, 1889

Tuesday Dec 4th 1894. Left San Francisco.
At 10 AM took anchor and
was towed to sea. At 1 PM tug let go. Steering
South by West. At 7 PM wind hauled to South
East, with rain. Heading S. S. West.

Wednesday Dec 5th Lat. 37.23. Long 123.48 W.
Begins with wind from the S East
with rain. Steering W by South. Saw one sail.

Thursday Dec 6th Lat 36.25 N. Long 124.28 W.
Begins with a moderate S West gale.
Steering to the West with rain. Heading from
S. S East to S. S West. Saw one sail.

MONDAY, OCTOBER 28, 1889

Friday Dec 7th Lat No Observation.
Begins with moderate S West wind. Heading W, S W.
Latter part a gale, wind hauling to the West.

Saturday Dec 8th. Lat 35.38 N. Long 125.54 W.
Fresh W, N West winds. Steering W, S West.
Latter part wind hauled to S W. Heading S East.

Sunday Dec 9th Lat 34.31 N. No Long.
Begins with a strong breeze from S West. Latter
part wind hauled to N W. Steering S W by South.

Monday Dec 10th Lat 33.27 N. Long 125.13 W.
Moderate wind from the North. Steering S W
by South.

Tuesday Dec 11th. No Observation.
Moderate wind from the S West. Middle
part hauled to N W. Steering S West.

Wednesday Dec 12th. Lat 30.35 N. Long 129.33 W.
Fresh breeze from the N. N West.
Steering S West. Letting up rigging, and repairing
sails.

Thursday Dec 13th. Lat 28.52 N. Long 132.19 W.
Fresh breeze from N to N E. Steering S West.
Repairing sails. Passed a Barque steering N West.
