Steering S W by West.

Monday Dec 31<sup>st</sup> Lat 14.47 N. Long 168.04 W.  
Moderate wind from the East. Steering S W.  
Middle part wind hauled to S W. Squally.

Tuesday Jan 1<sup>st</sup> Lat 13.10 N. Long 170.14 W.  
Fresh breeze from the S E. Heading S W by W.  
Rain squalls at intervals.

Wednesday Jan 2<sup>nd</sup> Lat 10.55 N. Long 171.51 W.  
Fresh winds from the East. Steering S. S West.  
Employed in hauling over blocks, and painting iron work.

Thursday Jan 3<sup>rd</sup> Lat 8.45 N. Long 173.21 W.  
Moderate wind from N East. Steering S. S W.  
Latter part wind hauled to S E.

Friday Jan 4<sup>th</sup> Lat 7.02 N. Long 174.30 W.  
Fresh breeze from E. S East. Steering S. S West.  
Rain squalls most of the day.

Saturday Jan 5<sup>th</sup> Lat 05.00 N. Long 175.52 W.  
~~No observations.~~ Steering S. S W  
Fresh breeze from E. S East. Heading S E.  
Rove new Main braces.

Sunday Jan 6<sup>th</sup> Lat 2.44 N. Long 177.46 W.  
Fresh breeze from the S E. Steering S. S West  
under all sail.

Monday Jan 7<sup>th</sup> Lat 00.22 N. Long 179.35 W.  
Moderate wind from the S E. Steering S. S W.  
Took in Larboard boat to repair. Rove new lower fore  
top sail braces.

Wednesday Jan 9<sup>th</sup> Lat 1.10 S. Long 178.12 E.  
Moderate winds from the East. Steering S W by S.  
Put out the Larboard boat, and took in Bow boat to repair.  
Tared fore and aft stays.

Thursday Jan 10<sup>th</sup> Lat 1.35 S. Long 176.42 E.  
Moderate winds from the East. Steering N W at 3 P.M.  
sighted the Island of Nukunau or Bygone Island.
