Friday Jan 11<sup>th</sup>

To day moderate Trades from N. East the boat laying off from Byrnes Island at 1 P.M. At 6 passed the Island of steering N. by West throughout the night wind light

Saturday Jan 12<sup>th</sup>

To day light Trades from N. East the boat heading in Westward

Sunday Jan 13<sup>th</sup>

To day fresh Trades from N. East steering the boat toward the Island of Krue at 3 P.M. passed to West

Monday Jan 14<sup>th</sup> To day light Trades from N. East the boat in sight saw a large white whale milk at near the hull

Tuesday Jan 15<sup>th</sup>

To day light Trades Ship Cruising off Halls Island saw white whale

Wednesday Jan 16<sup>th</sup>

Halls Island in sight Ship Cruising

Thursday Jan 17<sup>th</sup>

To day nearly calm at 2 P.M. raised a large school of Blackfish toward I got two from Island in sight

Friday Jan 18<sup>th</sup> Lat 1-15' N Long 122-35' W

To day light Trades from N. East Ship Cruising

Saturday Jan 19<sup>th</sup>

Lat 20 N Long 122-53 To day light Trades from N. East heading N. East
