

Remarks on board Bark Callao Antidard Bound
Official Time

Tuesday Sept 2nd 1842

At 10 AM got under way and stood out of the Bay with a fresh breeze from NW at noon
hove too and discharged the spit

Wednesday Sept 3rd

These 24 hours commenced with fresh breeze from
to NW steering S by E employed at standing
Anchors and Chained

Thursday Sept 4

These 24 hours commenced with Moderate Breeze
from the NW steering S by E employed
at fitting boats and getting ready for
sailing latter part wind E under all sail steering
SSE

Satt 37-59 Bany

Friday Sept 5th

These 24 hours commenced with Moderate Breeze
from the E heading to the SSE under all sail
at 8 PM strong breeze took in fore top gall
and gaff topsail at 9 PM increasing wind
took in the light sails and double reefed the
topsails the Watch employed at various
jobs about the ship

Satt Bany

Saturday Sept 6th

These 24 hours commenced with Breeze from the E heading
to the SSE under double reef topsails and
course at 11 PM Moderate sea with
latter part calm employed at standing
Sun observed at 11 AM
